| G.M. 602 SEALED CRATE ENGINE | 2200 pounds with the driver after the race |

| G.M. CT525 SEALED CRATE ENGINE | 2300 pounds with the driver after the race |

C.L.R. Engine Rules

- 1. Maximum 365 C.I. Any bore and stroke combination.
- 2. Any cast iron block, no aluminum block. Any steel crankshaft and rods, no titanium or other exotic materials.
- 3. Any pistons, oiling system, camshaft, rockers, lifters, and valves.
- 4. Any cast-iron or aluminum heads with factory valve to piston angle. Example: (23 degree heads on GM products)(20 degree heads on Ford products, except for Ford Racing Sportsman # M-6049-N-351) May use standard or raised runner heads (refer to weights). May angle mill the heads, must be with-in 3 degrees of factory stock. Any intake. May port and polish the heads and intake.
- 5. Any headers. Mufflers must be used.
- 6. Any bowl type carburetor. Racing fuel only, no alcohol allowed.

Tire Rule

Left Front – Any tire

Right Front – NLMT3

Left Rear - NLMT3

Right Rear - NLMT3 or 4
